This plan ensures our schools remain strong by addressing immediate needs while planning for the future.

The proposed upgrades will:

- Upgrade classrooms, locker rooms, and other key facilities
- Add a new weight room and competition gym, creating a space the entire community can take pride in

ANTICIPATED TAXES FOR \$24 MILLION BUDGET

The project will be financed over a 25-year period, funded through a 29-mill increase to the current property tax rate. See below for examples of how this would impact monthly expenses.
